



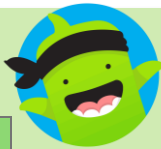

It's been a busy few weeks in Outdoor Education/PE with students from different groups getting out and about.

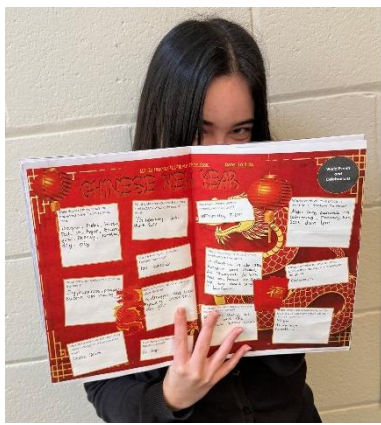
